This seminar will discuss the development of ASHRAE's Building EQ or Energy Quotient program and the important role that building energy labeling can play in meeting ASHRAE's Sustainability Goals.

The seminar will address our approach in developing the program and the objective of providing building owners with specific information on the performance of their buildings relative to similar buildings in the same climate zone. It will identify the three major aspects of the program - the Asset or "as designed" Rating, the "Operational Rating" and the underlying "Technical Data" supporting these ratings.

In addition the presentation will identify current ASHRAE education and certification programs being developed to support Building EQ
